2 Policy Objective

To safe guard the amenity and the financial viability of the Griffith region by blocking any proposals for the establishment of an intractable waste incinerator.

3 Policy Statement

- 3.1 Council shall oppose at every opportunity and at all levels and on all occasions the possibility of the establishment of an intractable waste incinerator in the Griffith region.
- 3.2 The area of the Griffith City Council is a declared nuclear waste free zone.

4 Definitions

Intractable waste: Waste whose toxicity or chemical or physical characteristics make it difficult to dispose of or treat safely, and is not suitable for disposal in Class I, II, III and IV landfill. For Example: Nuclear waste, toxic, non-biodegradable chemicals.
